UFO Challenge 2018-2019

What is a UFO ?

Our definition of a UFO is any project that has been started, purchased, dreamed of or wished for.

Challenge:

To finish those quilt project hidden in your sewing room or make the ones you have wanted to do for years.

There are many names for those unfinished quilt projects:

- WIPS - work in progress
- UFO's - unfinished objects
- NFUFO - nearly finished UFO's
- BBUFO - barely begun UFO's
- WISPs - works in slow progress
- WIVPs - works in very slow progress
- PIGs - projects in grocery sacks
- PIPs - projects in process
- PODs - projects of dreams
- WWIT - what was I thinking
- W - why?

Any of these sound familiar? This challenge is for you.

How to join: it's simple

1. Fill out the UFO challenge sheet with the names of ten of those projects (or add as many as you want, I have twenty-four)
2. Write your name on the top of the Challenge sheet
3. Make a copy of the UFO Challenge sheet for yourself
4. Turn a copy of the challenge sheet in at the next meeting to Billie Mohr or Laura Murrey.

Guideline:

A completed UFO is one that is ready for use. Quilt would need to be quilted bound and labeled to be a completed UFO. This includes Linus quilts, quilts of valor, ALS , quilts for kids, etc.,

After you have finished a project you can replace it with another UFO on your project list. Be sure and get us to update it on our list also.

We will be using the same UFO badges from last year so you can add more stars. If you are new you will of course get a new badge and a UFO Door hanger.

We will be Drawing a number at each meeting . That is the number of the quilt on your sheet you should work on that month. This has worked really well as a motivator for other UFO clubs. Who ever finishes that number quilt will draw the number for the next month. Of Course you can work on any UFO you want to this is just a idea to help us get to work..

Bring your completed UFO or a picture of it on your phone if you have already given it away, to the activities table at the meetings. You will receive a star to put on your UFO badge and you will fill out a UFO Ticket of Completion to be put in the drawing during the August guild meeting.

We hope you will show your completed projects for "Show and Tell". Please limit yourself to two per meeting due to time restraints. We would love to see them and hear the story behind them! Think how proud you'll be standing up and telling everyone "I finished this quilt" . Everyone applauded and you can take a little bow. FUN

For every UFO Completed on your list, your name will be entered into a drawing. At the August 2019 guild meeting we will draw a name for a prize! The prize will be a fantastic gift basket. The more quilts you finish, the more times you will be entered into the drawing.
